Mar 29 apr 19</p>	<p>Dollar Candy Bars – Purchase a variety bag of candy bars from the Mission Booth. Bag contains 15 candy bars and selling price is \$1 each. Teen Mission Account will be deposited with \$7.50 or \$0.50 profit for each candy bar. This is a year round fundraiser.</p>

Put your teen's name on the bottom of your receipt, so they will get credit.</p>	<p>Gordon Food Service – Shop year-round and present your Membership Card. We will receive up to 10% of our total sales depending on amount we spend each quarter. Membership Card application is available in the Fundraising Packet or stop by the Missions booth.</p>
<p>HelpMyTeam.com - Purchase gift cards from this web site and we receive 10% of our total sales. Many services can be purchased such as hotels, car washes, pizza, restaurants, limousine service, etc.</p>	<p>Kroger Cards – Purchase a \$5 gift card from the Mission Booth. Each time you shop put additional money on card prior to paying. We receive 5% of our total sales.</p>
<p>Meijer Community Rewards – Apply for a rewards card @ www.Meijer.com/rewards or pick up an application at the Missions Booth. Show this card every time you make a purchase with cash or a Meijer Credit Card and we receive 1-4% depending on total amount of purchases made each month. If you joined this program prior to May 2007, you must re-apply as their program has changed.</p>	<p>Ozark Suckers – Purchase a bag of 30 suckers from the Missions Booth for \$15.00. Suckers are sold for \$0.50 each. Teen Missions Account will be deposited \$6.90 or \$0.23 profit for each sucker. This is a year round fundraiser.</p>

<p>Penny Drive – During battle of the Sexes in February, we will have a penny drive with the girls vs. boys. We will be collecting pennies, but if anyone puts in any silver change, it will be subtracted from the total amount of pennies collected. Goal: If girls want to win, they may want to throw silver coins in the boy's container so that their total will go backwards! Each week we will total the containers to see who gets the points for that week.</p>	<p>Plymouth Whalers – We must sell 25 tickets for \$12 each for Saturday, February 2 game. At this game, we sell pucks for Chuck-A-Puck. We can sell between 800 – 1,000 pucks for \$1 each or 6 for \$5. Puck holders will have the opportunity to chuck their puck towards a target. Person with closest puck to the target will win a Plymouth Whalers Prize Pack. We keep money for all pucks sold.</p>
<p>Schwan's Food Service – February 6 – March 5 teens will have the opportunity to sell food items from their catalog. Products will be delivered to each person's home who placed an order. For every \$200 in sales received, a \$10 gift card will be awarded from Target or Wal-Mart. Stop by the Mission Booth and pick up your catalog.</p>	<p>Scratch & Help Booklet – Invite someone to scratch 2 spaces of the covered areas. The covered areas will reveal how much that person will donate to you (amounts range from \$0.50 - \$3.00). For participating they receive a coupon sheet for local businesses in the area. Once all areas are uncovered, you will have \$100 worth of donations. Stop by the Mission booth to pick up your booklet.</p>
<p>Scrip Gift Cards – Purchase gift cards from the Mission Booth for services and products that you would normally buy for your daily needs anyways. You purchase cards at face value and we receive 2 - 25% profit. Places include: Starbucks 7%, Payless Shoes 13%, Bath & Body Works 13%, Lowes 4% etc.</p>	<p>Sparkies Restaurant – Dine now through February 29 (excluding Friday & Saturday) and turn in your receipts to the Missions Booth & we receive 10% of our total sales. Put your teen's name on the bottom of your receipt, so they will get credit.</p>
<p>Todd's Services = When using Todd's for your landscaping, renovation & restorations, we receive 3% of every job completed.</p>	<p>VG's Food - Shop year-round and turn in your receipts to the Missions Booth to receive 1% of our total sales.
